GUIDELINES FOR DISTINGUISHED EDUCATOR AWARD

ELIGIBILITY

Any association member who has completed at least 3 years of service.

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Any OEA member may nominate candidates. To recognize a distinguished educator, submit letter(s) explaining the nominee's qualifications. All materials should be organized in a clear fashion and labeled with the nominee's name and assignment.

The Instructional Advocacy Committee will review all nominations and recommend a recipient to the OEA Board of Directors. The OEA Board will select the award winner. More than one nominee may be selected.
