Clarifying a few things... if you are an ELEMENTARY or a Program teacher you will only receive ONE ballot consisting of candidates for VP of Member Benefits and candidates for NEA RA Delegates.

- Elementary and Programs did not require an election for the OEA BoD. Ballots arrived at 8:00am.
- If you are a MIDDLE LEVEL teacher, you will receive **TWO** ballots consisting of candidates for VP of Member Benefits and candidates for NEA RA Delegates, your other ballot will have candidates for the Middle Level Rep position for the OEA BoD. **One ballot arrived at 8:00am and the second one arrived at 1:50pm.**
- If you are a SENIOR High-Level teacher, you will receive **TWO** ballots consisting of candidates for VP of Member Benefits and candidates for NEA RA Delegates, your other ballot will have candidates for the Senior High Level Rep position for the OEA BoD. **One ballot arrived at 8:00am and the second one arrived at 1:50pm.**
