Thank you for your hard work in the last few months. I have a couple of important updates for you.

November 3 and 4 Curriculum and Building Based PD days: Students will not have school those two days. On 11/3 staff will be fully remote due to the buildings being used as polling places) there will be two sessions for training from Apple and a 90-minute training from HMH for elementary teachers. The afternoon is for teacher planning and preparation but may be used for any collaboration with your team members. November 4 will include time for Building Base Professional Development. This may include any updates on procedures or other concerns that need to be addressed at the building level. The afternoon is to be used for teacher planning and preparation, but may also be used for collaboration with your team members.

Concerns: OEA has been in constant discussion with the district on a variety of concerns to be addressed. We are pushing for answers and will let you know what the district does with our recommendations. The topics we have discussed are workload, notification of COVID cases in the district, technology issues, and pacing guide concerns.
