Below is an update from Jacqelle...

I am conducting empathy interviews along with my colleague from New Mexico in my fellowship program. We are looking to collect data and talk with educators this year to work on solutions-oriented approaches and how our association can assist better with the satisfaction of educators in their profession this year.

Empathy interviews usually are one-on-one conversations that use open-ended questions to elicit stories about specific experiences that help uncover unacknowledged needs.

A protocol allows the interviewer to probe more deeply into stories than a more formal interview.
