**Elections:** If you have not yet done so, please take the time and exercise your right to vote today. The polls close at 8:00pm in both lowa and Nebraska.

**Negotiations:** The OEA and the district have set the first date for negotiations. It will be November 21, 2022, beginning promptly at 8:00am and conclude at 12:00pm, at the OEA office. It will be open to the bargaining unit. **If you would like to attend**, *you must adhere to the following expectations:* 

- Observers must enter the negotiation room and be seated before negations begin (arrive by 7:55am) and may not leave during active negotiations.
- Observers shall not in any way disrupt negotiations.
- Observers shall refrain from using personal computers, cell phones and other electronic devices.

As the negotiations progress, you will be provided with regular updates. The schedule of future dates and locations will be provided as they become available.
