GUIDELINES FOR

SPIRIT OF COLLABORATION AWARD

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Any OEA member may nominate candidates for the Spirit of Collaboration Award

All nominations must be made to the President of the OEA. The final date for the submission of nominations will be set annually by the OEA Board of Directors.

The nomination must be submitted on the official nominating form that may be obtained from the OEA Office. A maximum of ten (10) supporting letters may be submitted for examination by the screening committee.

NOMINATION

The Executive Committee of the OEA Board shall be responsible for screening all nominees. The Executive Committee shall recommend to the OEA Board of Directors, during executive session, the nominees they believe to be deserving of the award.

The OEA Board of Directors shall be the sole judge of who shall receive an award and how many awards will be given in any one year.

An award to be decided by the OEA Board of Directors will be awarded to the nominee or nominees receiving a simple majority vote of those Board members present in the executive session. Immediately following this executive session, an official meeting of the OEA Board of Directors shall be held. At that meeting, the vote of the Board in executive session naming the recipient or recipients of the Spirit of Collaboration shall be confirmed by official action of the Board. In this action, no reference shall be made to the specific recipient or recipients.
